**Palm Sunday**  
**Sunday 10<sup>th</sup> April 2022**

**FIRST READING : Isaiah 50:4-7;**

The Lord has given me a disciple's tongue.  
So that I may know how to reply to the wearied  
he provides me with speech. Each morning he  
wakes me to hear, to listen like a disciple.  
The Lord has opened my ear. For my part, I made  
no resistance, neither did I turn away. I offered  
my back to those who struck me, my cheeks to  
those who tore at my beard; I did not cover my  
face against insult and spittle. The Lord comes to  
my help, so that I am untouched by the insults.  
So, too, I set my face like flint; I know I shall not  
be shamed.

**SECOND READING : Philippians 2:6-11**

His state was divine, yet Christ Jesus did not cling  
to his equality with God but emptied himself  
to assume the condition of a slave and became as  
men are; and being as all men are, he was humbler  
yet, even to accepting death, death on a cross.  
But God raised him high and gave him the name  
which is above all other names so that all beings  
in the heavens, on earth and in the underworld,  
should bend the knee at the name of Jesus and that  
every tongue should acclaim Jesus Christ as Lord,  
to the glory of God the Father.

sheep is offered,  
Mankind is guilty, but the Son has  
suffered, for our atonement which  
we never heeded, God interceded.

For us dear Jesus was Your  
incarnation, Your bitter death and  
shameful crucifixion,  
Your burial and Your glorious  
resurrection, for our salvation.

Although good Jesus, we cannot  
repay You, We shall adore  
You and forever praise You,  
For all Your kindness and Your love  
unswerving, not our deserving.

O sacred head surrounded  
by crown of piercing thorn,  
O bleeding head sore-wounded,

Thy death for us did fashion  
our pardon and our peace.
