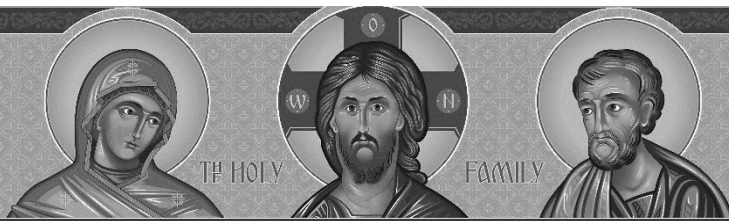

### FIRST READING : Daniel 7:13-14

### GOSPEL : John 18:33-37

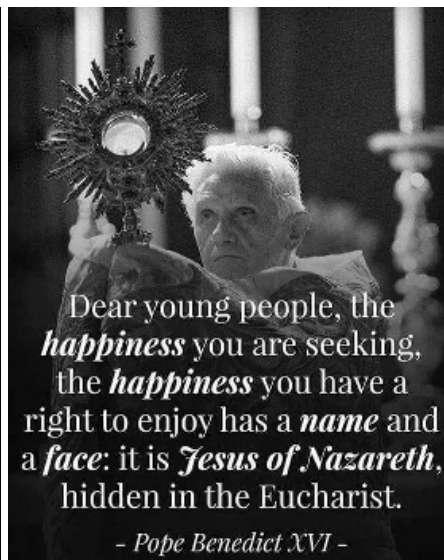
